Preview

THREE ESSENTIAL TRANSFORMATIONS:

FROM CHURCH GROWTH TO GOSPEL SATURATION

- The growth of our church is important but **Insufficient** (Acts 13:2)
- Our mission is to reach the city and the <u>World</u>! (Acts 1:8)

• We should **Work** together like a unified **Team** (v. 30,33,39-40)

- 1. What are your plans for Easter weekend?
- 2. In what way is Easter especially meaningful to you? What particular truth or promise has recently struck you in reference to Christ's sacrifice and finished work?

- 3. What were Paul and Barnabas called to do back in Acts 15:2? Why was this a sacrifice for their sending church in Antioch?
- 4. Why is the growth of our church important but insufficient?
- 5. Read John 12:24. How do you understand the principle of "gaining by losing?" How was it evident in Jesus' earthly mission? What is there to gain by such sacrifice among Christians?
- 6. What did Paul and Barnabas decide to do in v.39-41? What was gained by their sacrifice?
- 7. When you consider the many churches in Tampa Bay, how would you describe their collaboration and partnership? Why do you think that is?
- 8. Pastor Darin quoted Tom Hanks from "Saving Private Ryan" in reference to the soldiers hunkering down behind a bunker with the words, "If you stay here, you're dead men!" How does this relate to the local church? Why do you think the inward health of a church is heavily shaped by their outward movement?
- 9. What encourages inward inertia in a church? What encourages outward inertia in a church?
- 10. How might our community group and our church move further from collection to mobilization and from competition to collaboration with other churches?

- 11. How have you personally experienced the principle of "gaining by losing" in your Christian life? What sacrifice did you make, and how did it positively affect others?
- 12. How can you personally contribute to Oakwood's mission to become more outwardly-focused?
- 13. Who is someone you might invite to Oakwood for the Good Friday or Easter services?
